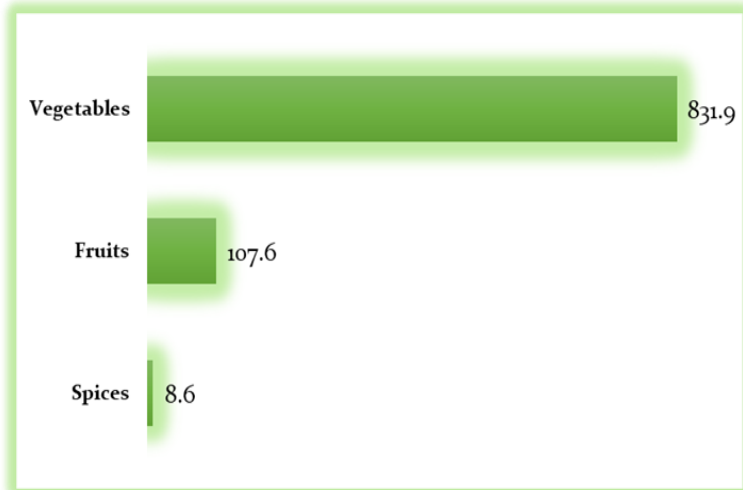


# Agriculture Produce sourced to Thimphu from January 20 to February 11, 2022

## Agriculture produce sourced

Over 948 mt of agriculture produce was sourced to Thimphu from January 20 to February 11, 2022 and distributed to zone shops and vegetable outlets.

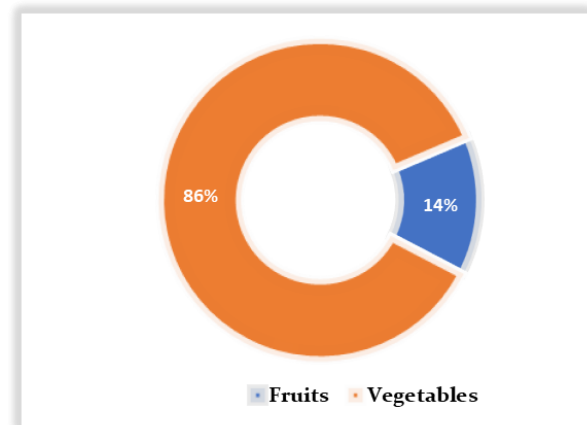
From the total volume, 25 percent of agriculture produce were domestically sourced while deficit was met through import.



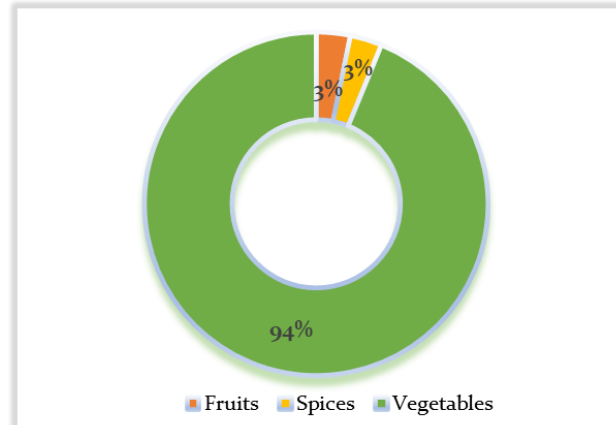
58.64 MT of different vegetables, 7.45 MT of fruits(banana and mandarin) and 6.99 MT of ginger were sourced to Thimphu from Chhukha, Punakha, Tsirang and Wangduephodrang. FCBL distributed about 160 MT of potato in Thimphu.

715 MT of agriculture produce was imported during this period. The major imports were vegetables (chilli, onion, cabbage and tomato, broccoli, egg plant and peas), fruits (banana and watermelon) and garlic. Except for chilli, other agriculture produces were imported by the wholesalers. FCBL supplied 124 MT of chilies in zone shops and vegetable outlets of Thimphu.
