The mandarin is one of the major export commodities and the export began from 28th October, 2022 with over one metric ton from Nganglam gateway. During this period, a total of 2,384.97 MT of mandarin were exported from Phuentsholing, Gelephu, Nganglam, Samtse and Samdrup Jongkhar gateways, with a total value of Nu. 90.64m.

Export to Bangladesh accounted for 86 percent of the total; the rest going to India. Around 2,049.11 MT worth Nu. 82.37m was exported to Bangladesh and 335.86 MT worth Nu. 8.27m was exported to India.

The biggest export occurred via Gelephu with over 1,419 MT worth Nu. 57.49m shipped during this period followed by Phuentsholing with over 260 Mt worth Nu. 10.04m. The highest offered rate recorded for the said period was Nu. 65/kg and the lowest was Nu. 9/kg.
